Submission of Papers

Only full papers can be submitted. All papers must include the following information: An abstract of up to 200 words, authors' full name and affiliation, contact details for corresponding author such as address, phone, and e-mail. All papers should be submitted (as PDF) to the organizing committee via the e-mail address cleen@beccle.uib.no no later than March 10, 2013. Proposals must be in English. Authors of accepted papers will be notified no later than April 2, 2013. Those who submit papers must be prepared to be assigned as discussant on one other paper.

The presentations from legal scholars or economists on topics dealing with competition or regulation will be followed by discussions of experienced researchers and further discussions with the audience.
